



ANGLE VALVE - SOFT DISC MODEL LV-AV

DESCRIPTION:

Lansdale's, "Angle Valve" is used primarily as a system drain valve or as part of the trim around a sprinkler valve. These valves are suitable for all types of systems up to 200 PSI. The soft seat design provides a positive seal and the 2" size is, usually used as a drain at the riser and can be used on both alarm valves as well as riser checks, (shotgun risers).

- Working pressure: 200 WOG
- Threads to ANSI B1.20.1 (NPT)


INSTALLATION:

Installation of the Lansdale, "Angle Valve" is done using standard industry methods. It is important to not over tighten any connections, and "hold-back" each component as the installation progresses. A suitable thread sealant such as Lansdale's, "Lanseal" or a Teflon pipe tape should be used on all male threads, to insure a positive seal. Do not over tighten the male threads entering the valve body as this can lead to thread damage and valve failure.
